

Did you know you can borrow magazines online using your library card? You Can! This is done through a service called RBdigital. This guide will walk you through getting started in borrowing magazines today.

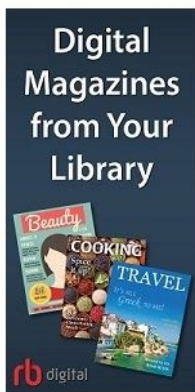
Personal Computer and Laptops:

Getting Started:

First we have to go to RBdigitals website. This can be done of one of two ways:

1. On the front page of our website (<http://www.cumberlandpubliclibraries.ca/>) scroll down until you see “*NEW* Online Magazines”, then click the link.





App Store Preview

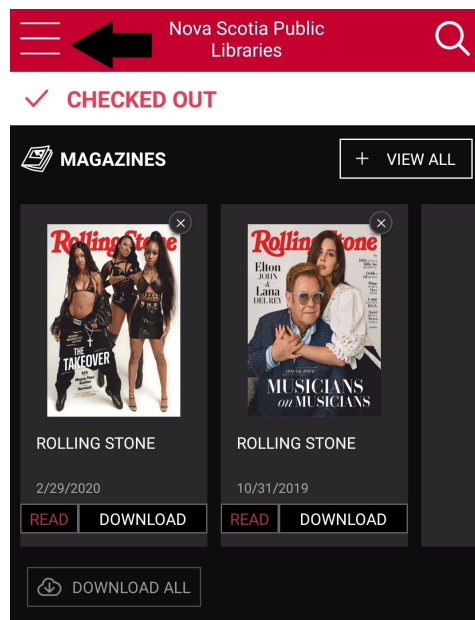


When opening the app you will be asked to sign in or make a new account.

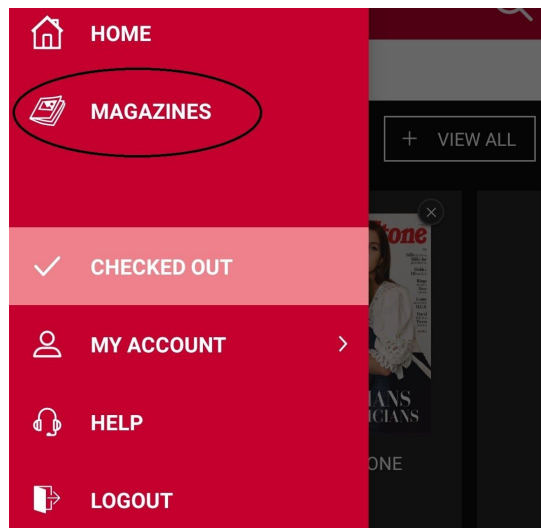
If you have already made an account on your computer then you are able to sign in right away.

Borrowing:

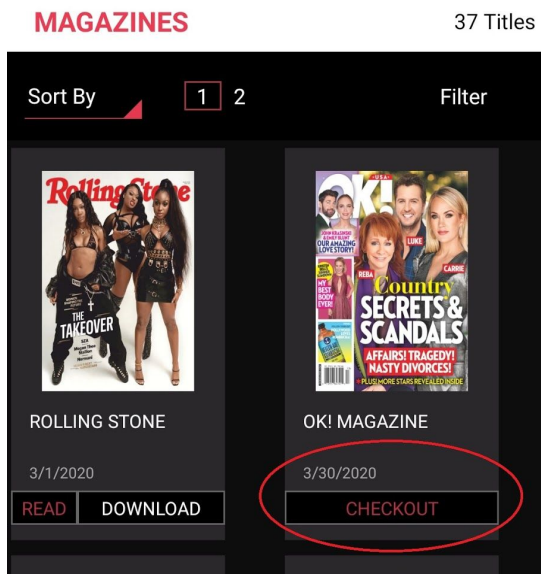
Press the menu icon in the top left.
